3. Organiser: Japan Ballroom Dance Council (JBDC)
- 4 Officially Recognized by National Dance Council for Japan (NDCJ/WDC)
5. Competition Details:
 - (1) Japan Dance Grand Prix:
For both sections (Standard and Latin), couples will be required to compete in all 5 dances from the Quarter-final
 - (2) Professional Rising Star Dance Competition
For both sections (Standard and Latin), couples will be required to compete in 2 dances. 4 dances from the semi-final.

8. About a health care and an unexpected accident

9. Honour Dance

The couples who win the first prize of Grand Prix will be required to perform Honour Dance in a specified dance.

10. Portrait Rights

The organizer will reserve all the portrait rights of the competitors and reserve all the rights to any reproductions of any scene of the events in any form.

11. Judging

- 1) Grand Prix: The panel of adjudicators for Grand Prix Professional will consist of nine adjudicators (Three WDC/oversea adjudicators, One Asia WDC/ adjudicator, Two NDCJ/WDC adjudicators and Three JBDC adjudicators).
- 2) Professional Rising Star ; Grand Prix: The panel of adjudicators for Grand Prix Professional will consist of nine adjudicators (Three WDC oversea adjudicators, One Asia WDC adjudicator, Two NDCJ/WDC adjudicators and Three JBDC adjudicators).

12 Entry Fees

- 1) Grand Prix: ¥6,000 with WDC registrations/the others ¥7,000 or ¥11,000 for one section (Standard or Latin)
- 2) Professional Rising Star: ¥6,000 for one section (Standard or Latin) as above.

- 1) The closing date for entries is Sunday, 21st May 2016.
No late entries will be accepted.

14.Exemptions

- 1) The top 12 couples in the national ranking, and the couples who danced the Final Round of the Balqua Cup 2015 will be seeded , and are exempt from the 2nd Round this year.
- 2) The exemptions only apply to the same partnership as existed in the aforesaid ranking or event, and not to the competitors individually.
The semi-final prizewinner of three big competitions in Britain participates from the final qualifier as a seeded competitor.
